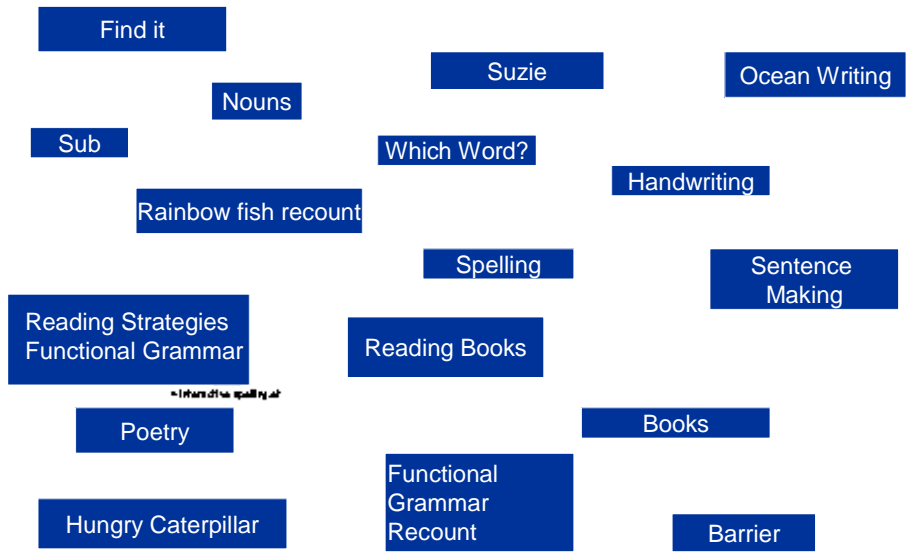
First thing when you get your board is read instructions & tutorials.

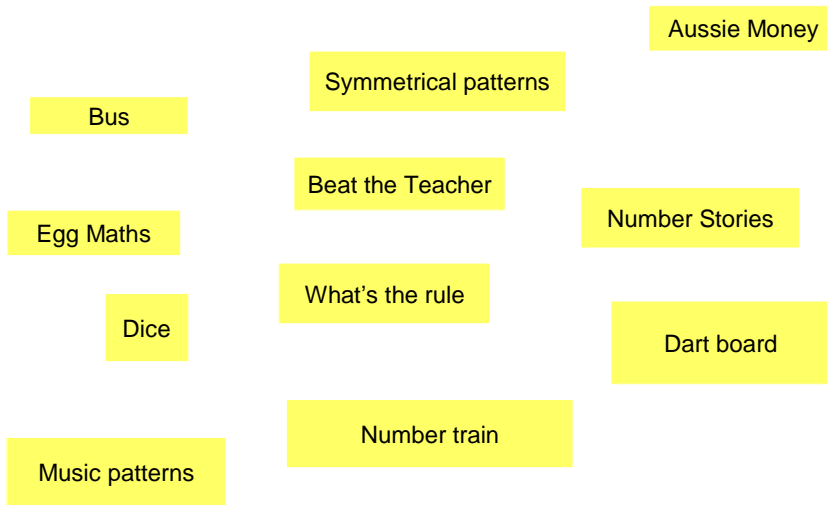
